Who Can Attend Music Day Camp?

Wind, Brass, Percussion Players:

- Entering grades 6–10 in Fall of 2010
- Minimum of one year of instruction

String Players:

- Entering grades 4–9 in Fall of 2010
- Minimum of one year private **or** two years of school instruction
- Ability to play in the keys of C, G, D, A, F, & B-flat

Ensemble Placement Levels:

(for band students only)

Symphonic Band:

An excellent choice for incoming 6, 7, and 8th graders!

- Players with 1–3 years experience
- Experience with playing in the keys of B-flat, E-flat, F, and A-flat major
- Know the chromatic scale in at least one octave
- Exposure to rhythms up to sixteenth note combinations

Wind Ensemble:

An excellent choice for incoming 9th and 10th graders!

- Players with 3–5 years of experience
- Proficiency in at least 8 key signatures
- Expanded range and tempo of scales including the chromatic scale
- Exposure to all sixteenth note combinations and triplet figures

How Does Ensemble Placement Work?

A detailed placement recommendation form is included in each registration packet. Your child's school band director or private lesson teacher should complete the form, recommending placement and return it to the student to mail to the VYOA.
